### **PASTOR'S JOB DESCRIPTION MORRISVILLE COMMUNITY CHURCH PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH USA**

The Pastor will provide spiritual leadership to the members of the church. Duties include preparing weekly sermons, preaching and conducting worship service. Further the Pastor will interpret biblical scripture as it applies to current day problems. The pastor will officiate at special occasions such as confirmation, baptisms, weddings and funerals. The Pastor will be the “Face” of the church in the community. The Pastor will abide by the By-Laws, policies and procedures adopted by the church. The Pastor will provide leadership, administrative oversight and organizational direction specifically as follows:

- To the Session, committees and the congregation as a whole in developing, coordinating and evaluating the stewardship program. This is in cooperation with the stewardship committee.
- To the congregation in assisting in the recruitment of new members
- To the education committee in leading Bible study and a Sunday School program
- Along with the Deacons, maintain a regular visitation program for the homebound and the sick
- To the choir director to integrate both traditional and contemporary music into the worship service
- To all committees and serve as a non-voting, ex-officio member of each

Evaluation - Performance Reviews will be conducted annually based on the annual work plan developed in cooperation with the personnel committee and approved by the Session and the Presbytery.
